RoboCup is a global robotics competition that promotes AI-driven problem-solving through challenges in rescue, soccer, and industrial automation. Regionally, it has grown into a platform where students apply machine learning, autonomous navigation, and sensor-based decision-making in real-world tasks.

Robo cup Nationals was held on January 11-12, 2025, in Bengaluru. Our students—Adhvan, Bhavya, and Aradhya—competed in the Rescue Line category. Their AI-powered robot autonomously navigated obstacles, identified victims, and performed rescue operations using sensor fusion and adaptive algorithms.

Despite being first-time national participants, their technical expertise and AI-driven strategies were praised.

This milestone reinforces our school's commitment to AI in education, inspiring students to explore automation, robotics, and intelligent systems for future challenges.
